

Carelon Behavioral Health (Mental Health & Substance Abuse) Benefits are Available to Non-Medicare PPO Plan Enrollees

The Carelon Behavioral Health member platform now features a chatbot that will address member inquiries related to claims such as: viewing existing or past claims information, viewing the status of an existing or past claim, and viewing an Explanation of Benefits (EOB) document for a claim.

In-Network Providers

- 90% coverage
- 10% coinsurance based on the contract allowance, not the charge(s)
- \$250 individual annual deductible (combined with all other PPO services)

Out-of-Network Providers

- 70% coverage
- 30% coinsurance based on the charge(s)
- \$500 individual annual deductible (combined with all the other PPO services)



Supplemental Check for Defined Pension Benefit Recipients

The Trustees of the Operating Engineers Pension Trust have approved the issuance of a supplemental pension benefit for 2024 (also referred to as a **13th Check**).

This additional benefit payment will be issued the first week of December 2024.

All individuals who were retired on June 1, 2024, and were eligible to receive a pension benefit in December 2024 will receive the supplemental check.

The supplemental check will match the amount of each eligible member's monthly pension benefit to a maximum benefit payment of \$500.00.

If your monthly pension benefit is being withheld or is suspended as of December 1, 2024, the supplemental check will not be awarded. Once pension benefits are reinstated, the supplemental check will be issued.


Engineers Pension Trust and the Operating Engineers Defined Contribution Plan.
